Application Guidelines

- 1. Open to YCSA MEMBERS and children of CSA MEMBERS in Alberta.
- 2. Applicants will be no older than 25 years as of January 1st 2020.
- 3. Qualified applicants will be pursuing a post-secondary education preferably in an agricultural related field.
- 4. Qualified applicants should demonstrate a level of activity within the Alberta Simmental beef industry and/or Alberta Young Canadian Simmental events.
- 5. Qualified applicants should demonstrate an above average level of interest in academic achievement.
- 6. The applicant <u>must include</u> a copy of their most current post-secondary academic year transcripts and/or a letter of acceptance to a post-secondary institution, along with their latest high-school transcript.
- 7. If you have received this scholarship once you cannot receive it again.
- 8. Applications will be reviewed by a group of at least 3 persons as selected by the Alberta YCSA Scholarship committee.
- 9. Applications need to be received by the Alberta YCSA by **September 1**st, **2020.** Late applications will not be considered. Your application should include the application form, two typed paragraphs, and your transcripts. Reference letters and resumes are **not required.**
